E-STATEMENTS

If you are already using Home Banking we would like to encourage you to sign-up for E-statements. With E-statements you will get your monthly or quarterly statements usually the 2nd day of the month following the statement period. You will receive an email informing you that your statement is ready to view.

E-statements are accessed within the home banking site so there is only one log in needed. Simply click on the icon of the tree on home banking to sign up.



NEW CHECK ORDERS

If you need to re-order checks for your account, and you have the re-order slip, you can proceed to order the checks yourself by going to the website listed on the re-order form included with your last order of checks.

If you have ordered checks from our new vendor, CPS, you can access the check re-order website from our website at www.global1fcu.com. Simply click on the CPS Logo and it will take you to their website. Their site knows all of the information such as your last check number and the check design you have used in the past. You will also be able to browse all of the current check designs they have available.

When ordering from a new company such as the ones in the Sunday Paper, please make sure you use the numbers on the bottom of your current checks exactly as it appears there. This will ensure proper credit to your account.

Applications are available at our website (www.global1fcu.com) or by calling the office.

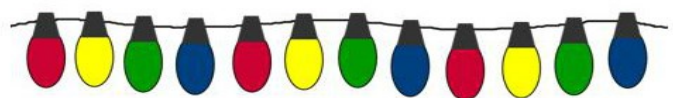
Please complete the application front and back. It is necessary to list a reference with contact information and list your mortgage/rent.

Please submit the application along with two recent pay stubs.

Loans will range from \$500 to \$1000 with a 11 month repayment term. The rate will be 10% as set by our board of directors. Your credit score will determine if you qualify for either the \$500 or \$1000 loan.

We will not be keeping a list this year and will process applications in the order in which they are received.

There will be a \$10 loan application fee which can be financed into the loan
